### OUR UNIVERSITY OPPORTUNITY FOR EUROPEAN DEGREE

The University of Audiovisual Arts, European Film, Theater and Dance Academy, Skopje-Paris-Rotterdam-Essen started operating in 2007 and is the first private University in the field of audiovisual arts in Macedonia.

The founder of the University is Mr. Jordan Plevnesh, a prominent playwright, novelist and screenwriter, known on all five continents and translated into fifty languages worldwide.

At the very beginning, the direct connection with ESRA from France enabled the drawing of significant experiences from the country of the Limier brothers and our establishment as a serious higher education institution in the field of audiovisual arts. Europe, our common home, says Jean Monnet, has become a field in which the horizons of cooperation with one of the oldest universities, with extraordinary references Volkwang from Essen, Germany and just before that with the exclusive Dance Academy of Rotterdam Netherlands, have opened up to us with exceptional energy. In that way, we turned the adjective "Euro-

pean" from a dream into reality!

The very establishment of the International University Europa Prima, crosses the European experiences from the audiovisual areas with the tradition and experiences in the Republic of Macedonia and South-Eastern Europe. It is especially important to mention the introduction of several departments from the audiovisual areas for which so far in Macedonia and in the countries in the Region, there has been no possibility for higher education, academic education.

The University is conducting an educational activity of first cycle studies, with which the student acquires 180 ECTS and a corresponding title in the field, BA (Bachelor of Arts). With the second cycle studies, ie. Master's degree in the field of arts The student will acquire 60 or 120 credits, which together with the credits from the first cycle of studies constitute 300 credits, thus acquiring the title MA (Master of Arts).

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ENROLMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY

#### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENROLLMENT**

Candidates for the first cycle of studies (undergraduate) at Europa Prima International University have the opportunity to apply in the period between June 1 and September 10.

Candidates for the second cycle studies (postgraduate, specialist and master) can apply in the period between June 1 and October 15.

#### RULES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE DURATION OF THE STUDIES

#### **Enrollment for the semester**

Each student must enroll in the semester within the deadline set by the University. When enrolling in the semester, the student enters the compulsory and elective courses, which he / she must pass.

#### Condition

A condition for enrollment in each subsequent semester is the passing of all compulsory subjects. Students have the right to take the elective courses in three sessions.

#### Semester certification

The student, after listening to the necessary number of compulsory and elective courses, acquires the right to certify the semester. Each completed semester must be certified.

#### **Enrollment for the semester**

Each student must meet the requirement to enroll in each subsequent semester. The number of exams taken for the condition is five.

#### **Registration for exams**

Each student is obliged to register for the exams within the announced deadline. Each application must be completed correctly and clearly, otherwise it will not be considered.

#### Sessions

Each semester is followed by a two-deadlines for passing of exams. Every September between 1-15th is the last correctional session in which the student must have passed all the exams. In the first session, the student must pass five subjects, primarily the compulsory ones, and the remaining subjects he / she will have to pass in the next two sessions.

#### Colloquiums and exams

Each student has the opportunity to take some of the courses through colloquia, and in order to obtain a grade, he / she must pass all the colloquia continuously.

#### **Evaluation method**

According to the Bologna system, each student is monitored and evaluated throughout the semester. Of the possible 100% of the grades, 49% fall on regularity, activity and project activities, and 51% on the grades from the final exam, ie from the colloquia.

#### On hold status

Every student has the right to put their studies on hold if they are unable to continue for health, financial or other reasons. The conditions for the status of dormant studies are specified in the Study Agreement.

#### INSTITUTE OF PERFORMING ARTS

The Institute of Performing Arts, from the International University

Europa Prima, is the organizer of the long-term, international research project:

"The European Theater and Dramaturgy in "Macedonia from liberation until today",

presenting the theater and drama of 30 individual European counties, and covering events and activities in dramaturgy, theater and publishing, which have left a deep mark on our European cultural memory.

Each year two countries are presented in this project. So far, the Bulgarian,

German, Serbian and Italian drama and theater were presented, with participation of university professors, theatrologists, theater critics and other theater figures from the Republic

Macedonia and the respective countries.



Institute of Performing Arts at IU Europa Prima has published a collections of papers presented at the symposia, and anthologies of texts translated into Macedonian language from the mentioned countries.

### INSTITUTE OF AUDIOVISUAL STUDIES AND DIGITAL PROTECTION

Within its scientific research activity, the Institute of Audiovisual

studies and digital protection at IU Europe Prima publishes the scientific journal "Link", covering the field of audiovisual arts and media.

"Link" is a platform for collaboration, between the Republic of Macedonia, the Balkans and European countries, in the field of audiovisual arts. "Link" is detecting the contributions in the development of the overall cultural and social political relations, of the relevant stakeholders in the development of the modern media scene in Europe.

In this context, the importance of this role of Link magazine has been well demonstrated, serving as a roadway for overall mutual cooperation between the Republic of Macedonia and European countries in the process of European integration.

This idea, that today is a reality, is the result of initiatives by eminent cultural figures, intellectuals, and institutions, from the field of culture, in the direction of intensification and developing of the international cooperation.



#### **DOCTOR HONORIS CAUSA**

International University Europa Prima, since its establishment, has introduced the practice of declaring important personalities in the field of audiovisual arts as Honorary Doctors. Doctor Honoris Causa. Any proclamation of these legends of audiovisual creation is a real celebration of our University, which resonates in the Balkans, in Europe and in the World.

### FILM AND TV DIRECTING

Academic and technically ready staff in the field of film and TV directing will be educated at this Faculty. The student of film and TV directing will be established as an artist and professional in a wide range of cinematographic forms and genres both in the field of film and in the field of television.

The teaching of this department, in addition to the home, professional, and theoretical subjects, is also organized through a very extensive practical work, student exercises – studio and field.

### **FILM AND TV CAMERA**

Through film and TV camera studies, students gain the knowledge and experience necessary for a film and TV cameraman's career, as well as a Director of Photography. The camera student will be formed as an artist and professional in a wide range of cinematic forms and genres both the film and television fields.

### **FILM AND TV MONTAGE**

Film and TV editing studies, with their professional and artistic profile, prepare the student as a professional and artist for the final stage of the film process, for feature films, documentaries and television forms, commercial and music videos and multimedia.

### **PRODUCTION AND MANAGEMENT**

In the Department of Production and Management, students will gain knowledge about the characteristics of television, new media and of course film and theater art. The main emphasis will be on the study of the production process through the application of management principles in management, as well as mastering the techniques of project management in planning, organization, management and marketing, understanding the specifics of the application of management in the arts.

### **PHOTOGRAPHY**

Photography studies are another exclusivity of the University of Audiovisual Arts, as a department that is established for the first time in the Republic of Macedonia. The wide application of photography as a medium provides a wide field of professional realization. This is exactly the reason for the mass interest in this field of the visual medium, which offers future students a creative, dynamic, provocative professional career. But photography, as well as art in general, requires a great and deep daily commitment. Or, as they say, art is not a profession; it's a way of life.

**SUBJECTS** • Photography, history of photography, photography technology, studio photography, digital post-production, optics, psychology, mask and makeup, art history, basics of costume design, basics of scenery, camera ...





What is especially important for 3D Animation studies is the international application of the knowledge acquired at the University of Audiovisual Arts. There is a huge shortage of professionals in this field in Macedonia, which results in the hiring of experts from the surrounding Balkan

For the first time in Macedonia and for the first time in a large number of countries in Southeast Europe, one of the most sought after professions in the world began to be studied at our University. When we consider the fact that in the wider region there are more than six hundred music studies, and very few sound engineers, graduates in European and Atlantic countries, future students of the University of Audiovisual Arts, who will choose the profession of sound engineer, will be able to engage in a number of institutions in the audiovisual field.

Following the new trends and needs of future students this year at the Faculty of Production of Tone, we decided to supplement the existing Sound Engineering department with two more specific departments: Music Production and Electronic Music Production.

#### STUDY PROGRAM: FILM AND DIGITAL MEDIA

The "Film and Digital Media" curriculum will combine several aspects - work on the film's alphabet and digital media tools and platforms, dramaturgy, analysis of basic dramatic elements, developing the ability to tell a story, as well as dealing with the design and composition of a video game story that includes articulation of virtual spaces and interactive predictions. We will work on the most important features of the structure of the new or digital media and how they correspond to the film as a conventional platform for transfer of content. The program will monitor the development of the creative industries as well as most of the technologies used in making or tracking the same. The context of digital media and platforms, their development over the centuries and their current social and cultural impact will be analyzed. On the other hand, the overall development of technologies from the advent of photography to the present day will be included and the new standards that new technologies impose from a quantitative, qualitative, structural and content aspect will be obtained. As an interdisciplinary program these studies will focus on offering theoretical in-depth knowledge, as a prerequisite, to better understand other teaching courses.

### **VIDEO GAMES AND VR**

Dramaturgy of the new media is quite new discipline, and its fast becoming a necessity, at least at its basic level.

To this end, the curriculum will combine several approaches and modalities: work on the alphabet of theatrical and film dramaturgy, analysis of the basic dramatic elements, developing the ability to tell a story, as well as dealing with design and composition of a video game story which include virtual articulation spaces and interactive predictions.







### **SOCIAL MEDIA**

In the today's media which is developing fast, the social media will not only become a fundamental tool for communication but a necessary tool in many industries. With the right combination of practice and education in social media, students and professionals are trained with competitive advantage in their studies, carriers and communication.

This course will teach students how to create and maintain presence on social media for business, including facebook, twitter, google +, tumblr, linkedin, youtube, instagram etc. Students will learn to use social media for public relations and communications.

### CREATIVE INDUSTRIES AND NEW TECHNOLOGIES

Course "Introduction to creative industries and new technologies" is a short outline of the history, theory and critic of all creative industries, as well as the various technologies used in the making or following of the same. The course will focus on analysing the context of the creative industries, their development throughout the centuries and their influence in today's society and culture. On the other side the entire development of the technologies will be covered from the appearance of photography to today and the new standards that the new technology impose from quantitatite qualitative, structural and content aspect.

### **PROGRAMMING**

The students will be trained in the fundamentals of programming, in order to be able to create digital products that have interactive component which dramatically is a new field of research. The primary aim is to enable students to produce interactive creative product - video game, with regard to the concept, management resources all the way to displaying graphics on computer screen. The program will not focus on studying specific language but rather logical essence of programming of one computer system, through the introduction in part and the reasoning of operation of a computing machine.

Students will be trained in the technical side of producing animation in computing environment, setting lights and defining of their behaviour in the computer, technical aspects in manipulation of program code to get the desired material on a given surface in the video game, as well as basic concepts for work in a tridimensional surrounding in the computer.

Students will become familiar with the technological aspect of production autonomous characters in interactive environment with the help of artificial inteligence.

### DIGITAL ENTERPRENEURSHIP

The number of people who are participating in sharing of information, knowledge, data and goods is increasing. This so-called "sharing economy" is still at an early stage of its development and therefore this curriculum aims at detailed addressing of what this young phenomenon has to offer. There are various aspects of the economic phenomenon for sharing. The research for this phenomenon usually reflects on the new business models, "start-ups" and directly influences the understanding of the sharing economy. From here we can clearly see the difference between the relevantness of economic and social orientation. Secondly, the social orientation is in greater demand when it

comes to consumers rather then the enterpreneuers. The fast growing

digitalization has brought change in life situations that are characterized with urbanity, openess to new solutions, changes in work situations and new way of thinking. All these aspects drive the sharing economy. The purpose of this teaching subject is to explain the request, the engines and the purpose of the sharing economy. Given the limited research in this area, the developed framework is a strong basis for discussion, criticism and/or support of future research.


